
The IB Diploma Programme **A Broad and Balance Education**



 Westlake Magnet Program believes in evaluating the whole students. Acceptance into the program is determined by all four components: overall numeric average, discipline record, entrance exam performance, and both teacher or advisor recommendations into the overall student evaluation to determine acceptance.

Application FAQ

Can you confirming you received my application? The online general application is processed by Fulton County Schools. The Westlake Magnet Office is unable to provide confirmation of completion. Please contact the FCS Advanced Studies Department.

I made a mistake; how do I fix it. If you made a mistake in the application, please resubmit a new completed application.





Teacher Recommendation FAQ

Verify you are including the correct email address for each instructor included in the teacher recommendations. I will only send the recommendation to the email listed in the application.

Where do I send the teacher recommendation? The Magnet Coordinator will use the teacher emails you provided in the application to request a teacher recommendation directly from the teacher. Recommendations must be completed using the link provided to the instructor.

How will I know if the teachers completed the recommendations? Families and students can ask the teachers if they completed the recommendation. The Magnet Office does not provide this information directly to the families.

We ask that you consult with your family calendar in choosing the desired test date. Each family is ONLY able to schedule **ONE** appointment for the Entrance Exam.

Any missed appointment forfeits the opportunity to test for our 2024-2025 school year as there will not be any rescheduling options.

Entrance Exam FAQ

What is the passing score for the entrance exam for students to be admitted? There is not passing score for the exam. Your student's exam score will be entered into the applicant rating formula with the other components to determine their applicant score. Students with applicant score of 8 or higher will be accepted into the program.





Residency Requirements

To be eligible for the Westlake Magnet Program, families must reside within the Fulton County School's school district.

Students who are not zoned for an FCS high school will not be allowed to register for the program, regardless of application decision.






